**Programmatic Focus:** Our CSR programs addressed critical areas such as environment, water conservation, education, and community development.



**Volunteer Engagement:** We mobilized around 372 volunteers who contributed 1492 volunteering hours to our CSR initiatives.



#### **SBI** donates ₹48L for saplings

Bengaluru: The State Bank of India (SBI) has planned to donate Rs 48 lakh to Garden City University for planting 32,000 tree saplings in Bengaluru in association with That's Eco Foundation. An MoU has also been signed between the three organisations. The project is being implemented using Miyawaki technique introduced by a Japanese botanist Akira Miyawaki which helps in building dense and native forests. It ensures that the plant growth is 10 times faster and the resulting plantation is 30 times denser than usual. The dense multilayered forests created under this method are beneficial in lowering temperature, making soil nutritious, supporting local wildlife and sequestration of carbon.
